

MedX Inventory Management System

The MedX solution is flexible and adapts easily to suit your departments' workflow and processes, therefore you determine your own hardware requirements and investment, as devices can be shared within a location and not on a per person basis.

Controlled drug management

An electronic CD register, OmniCD also sits within the reporting structure of MedX which will provide you with the reporting tools you need for storage and monitoring of controlled drugs independently or together with Omnicell's point of care solutions. OmniCD report captures the entire movement of controlled drugs from the moment it is added as a stock item to when it is administered. Like all other Omnicell automated systems, OmniCD requires a unique password and user IDs so that every interaction can be traced back to the source.





